




Players must accept the challenge of testing for their next rank in order to develop self-confidence and an understanding of the value of working for a goal.








"Arise! Awake! and don't stop till the end result is achieved.


WAKO India Shadow Kick boxing Open Challenge sponsored by Fightex was held from 20th January to 4th Feb 2023.


