





























2ND WAKO INDIA OPEN INTERNATIONAL KICKBOXING TOURNAMENT FROM 2ND - 6TH NOVEMBER 2022, NEW DELHI



The "2nd Indian Open International Kickboxing Tournament" was organized by WAKO India Kickboxing Federation and took place from November 2–6, 2022, at the Talkatora Indoor Stadium in New Delhi.

All of the team members arrived at the venue on the first day and completed the registration process, which was followed by the medical test and weighing-in. This procedure must be followed in order for the game to be transparent and fair. It's always enjoyable to watch the fired-up youths getting ready to win the competition and represent their team with pride.

The location was fitted with 1 Ring 3 Tatami spaces. There were total 811 entries, 551 Players, 115 Referees, 46 Coaches and 16 officials from both India and abroad who participated in the event in total.











On November 3, the "5th International Kickboxing Referee Seminar" took place. All of the Tournament Referees who attended the seminar, deemed as "Technical Training Seminar," learned the Kickboxing rules, techniques, and procedures for awarding points during ring fights. Mr. Yury Lakhtikov (Estonia), Chairman of the Referees Committee, Ring Sports, WAKO (IF), was the seminar's featured speaker and presented to all the referees on the kickboxing rules and techniques. He spoke about topics such as Minimum Suspension Periods after KO, Prohibited Techniques in Ring Sports disciplines, Minus Point Criteria, Warnings and Minus Points, Disqualification Process, Legal Techniques in Low-kick and Target Area, and Decision Making Process, which are all related to refereeing kickboxing matches. Mr. Sanjay Kumar, Chairman of Referee Committee, Ring Sports, WAKO (India), was present.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, Mr. Brian Beck, Chairman of the Referee Committee for Tatami Sports WAKO (IF), was unable to obtain a visa in time, so Ms. Seema Saini, a member of the WAKO Referee Committee, took over to lead the seminar. Mr. Kartik Dakua, Chairman of Referee Committee, Tatami Sports, WAKO (India), was present.

The tournament's qualification rounds were divided into four zones: Ring 1, Tatami 1, Tatami 2, and Tatami 3. The qualifications featured 200 fights in total, including 61 fights on Tatami 1, 80 fights on Tatami 2, 40 fights on Tatami 3, and 19 ring fights.

The tournament was participated by both men and women with great enthusiasm. The women's section saw a total of 55 fights, while the men's section saw 145 fights.
