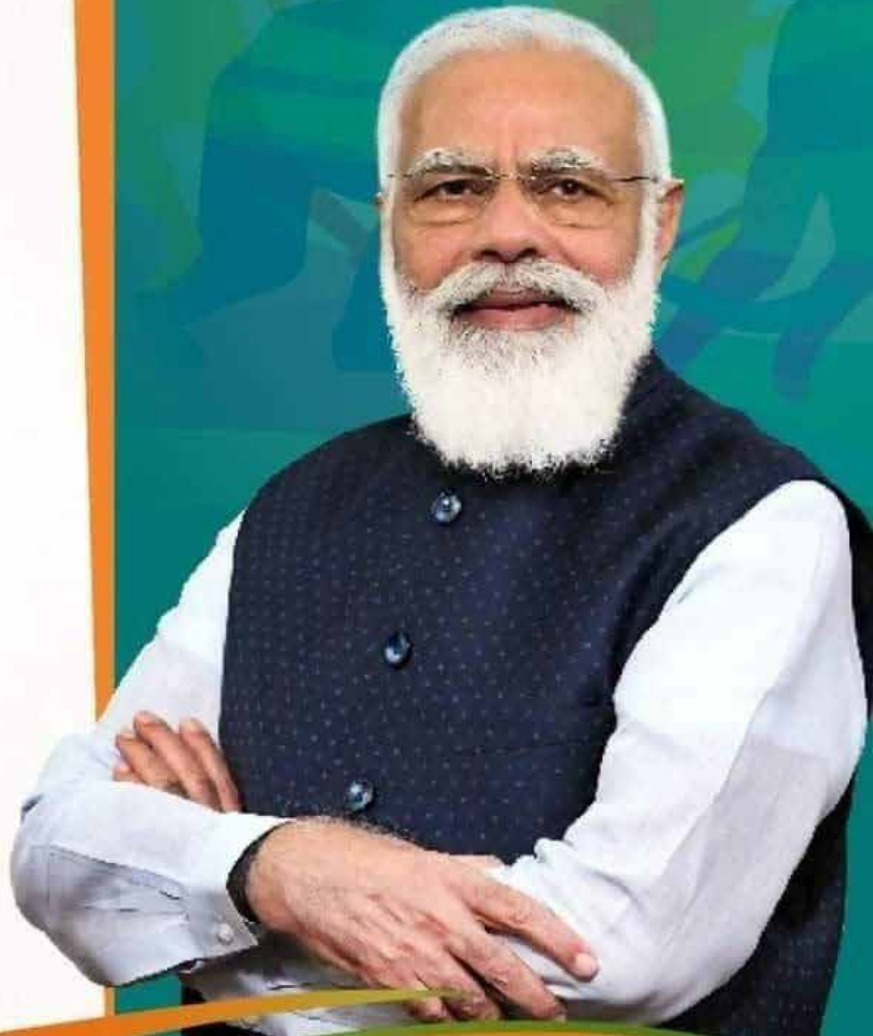

HISTORY OF WAKO INDIA

WAKO India came into existence in India with the name and style "Indian Association of Kickboxing Organization (IAKO)" in the year 1993 to promote, govern and regulate Kickboxing Sport in the country on behalf of World Association of Kickboxing Organizations (WAKO-IF), Italy. Later on, the organization was renamed as "National Kickboxing Federation NG" in the year 2013.

In order to give a new shape and dimension to Kickboxing Sport in the country, the Federation had to undergo one more change in the name and its set up. As a result of this mandatory change took place in the month of June' 2017, "National Kickboxing

Federation NG" has now renamed as "WAKO INDIA KICKBOXING FEDERATION" (WAKO INDIA) with Head Quarters & Registered Office at No.7, 1st Floor, Achievers Centre Point Mall, Sector-49, Faridabad-121 001, Haryana, India. This Federation, popularly known as "WAKO INDIA" is now headed by Mr. Santosh K. Agrawal, as President.

WAKO INDIA KICKBOXING FEDERATION (WAKO INDIA) is the sole representative of WORLD ASSOCIATION OF KICKBOXING ORGANIZATIONS (WAKO-IF), ITALY.

WAKO INDIA KICKBOXING FEDERATION - AN INTRODUCTION

"WAKO India Kickboxing Federation" as the National Governing Body to control and develop Kickboxing Sport activities, in all age groups and styles both in male and female categories, in India. WAKO India also has membership of Asian & International Federations working under Olympic Charter and Fold.

'WAKO India Kickboxing Federation' is affiliated to World Association of Kickboxing Organizations (WAKO) International Federation head quartered in Italy. Due to its affiliation with WAKO (IF), "WAKO India Kickboxing Federation", popularly known as "WAKO INDIA" is presently headed by Mr. Santosh K. Agrawal as a President having its Registered National Office at No. 7, 1st Floor, Achievers Centre Point Mall, Sector – 49, Faridabad – 121001, Haryana.

WAKO (IF) is recognized by International Olympic Committee (IOC). WAKO (IF) has global presence. Across the globe, total 145 countries are affiliated to WAKO (IF). Earlier, WAKO India stood at 89th position in the ranking of WAKO (IF) among 145 countries. By its persistent hard work, at present WAKO India has attained 47th position in world ranking and continuously making efforts to go close to the top global ranking. In Asian continent, WAKO India is at 3rd ranking among Asian countries.

WAKO India has 32 Affiliates across the country which includes States and Union Territories and all of them are registered with the respective State Sports Authorities and a few of them have recognition from State Olympic Associations. Since their existence, all these Affiliated Associations are working very closely with their Sports Authorities and State Olympic Associations for the development of Kickboxing Sport in the country. All these 32 Affiliates have representations in their respective State through Associates at District level thus ensuring development of Kickboxing Sport at village level.

WAKO India has been conducting a lot of competitions in the country with the help of our Affiliates, Sports Authorities and State Olympic Associations and received an overwhelming response to Kickboxing Sport activities.

WAKO India is regularly imparting technical education and upgrading all the concerned Referees and Coaches time to time by conducting various technical seminars/training camps and event. Reputed famous International Referees and Coaches are being invited in these technical seminars and events to uplift the level of our Technical officials to International level.

WAKO India has made nation proud by winning two gold and one bronze medal in "World Cadets and Junior Kickboxing Championships" held in Italy in September 2018, where we stood at 25th place in the World medal tally among 65 countries across the globe.

Also in the year 2020, we made India proud when WAKO India conducted very first time, very successfully 'WAKO Indian Open International Kickboxing Tournament' at Talkatora Stadium in New Delhi wherein 12 countries participated. This was indeed a proud moment for India where all the International community realized and appreciated well by submitting that "India is having a great International potential in Kickboxing sport". We proudly say that our efforts were well appreciated by WAKO (IF) and other countries.

In India, this sport has been recognized by the 'School Games Federation of India (SGFI)' at the school level and 'Association of Indian Universities (AIU)' at the university level by including it in their sports calendar.

Recently, 'WAKO INDIA KICKBOXING FEDERATION' officially recognized by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of INDIA as National Sports Federation on 02nd July 2021. This is recognition and NSF status helped WAKO India to take forward its ultimate aim of 'Redefining Kickboxing Sport in INDIA'. Mr. Santosh K. Agrawal, President of WAKO INDIA took this day of historic and milestone achievement as an occasion for all persons related with Kickboxing sport in India for celebration and declared 2nd July as a "National Kickboxing Day" for the sport of Kickboxing in India.

THE KICKBOXING - A Hybrid Sport With Roots In Ancient Techniques



Kickboxing is one of the youngest martial arts systems and one of the fastest growing. Kickboxing has been in existence since the early 60s. Its conception came about because of the desire of Martial Artists to test their skills against each other in a safe and controlled environment. It requires a high level of fitness both mentally and physically and is a dynamic and effective Martial Art. It incorporates kicking, punching, sweeping and throwing.

Kickboxing is practiced as a Full-contact Sport, practiced in a boxing ring and as a lighter version sport, practiced on Tatami. All disciplines are very entertaining and popular and attract youth and women all over the world.

Protection in the contact sports: mouth-guard, hand-wraps, boxing gloves, groin-guard, shin-pads, kick-boots, and helmet.

WAKO started its activities in Europe in 1976 and created the rules and regulations for the new fighting sport and acted, as the Kickboxing Federation of the World.

Kickboxing is also really good for physical fitness and Self-Defense to show skills in the safest manner.

WAKO KICKBOXING TODAY:

Kickboxing is a modern contact fighting sport created on the basis of many traditional combat sports and martial arts. Kickboxing is a unique Western response to many Eastern martial arts. It can be practiced on competitive or recreational level depending on the aspirations of the kickboxer, but for sure it is a sport designed to improve your overall health, strength and endurance.

His near-death experiences birthed his spiritual awakening and made him realise the power of God, and he started writing and giving motivational talks. The former IPS motivated shared his life experience and ensured every single person out of the hall had a smile on his face.

7th International Turkish Open Kickboxing World Cup 12th to 15th May 2022

In a city like Istanbul, it was a nice way to promote the 2nd Indian Open International Tournament by none other than WAKO President, Mr. Roy Baker and Romeo Desa - Chairman Technical Committee - WAKO (IF) and the Vice President - Mr. Espen Lund. The event under the Management of WAKO Turkey President, Mr Salim Kayici was superb and was an example where a developing country can learn a lot of process and the smooth functioning of an event. This is truly a proud moment for the nation and for all the Kickboxing lovers in India for touching a newer height and setting a new benchmark.

The 15 members delegation of Team India which was led by Mr Lokesh Sinhal, Vice Chairman of WAKO India Kickboxing Federation & Senior Additional Advocate General of Haryana State. Mr Santosh K Agrawal, President of WAKO India along with his 2 coaches, Mr Suresh Babu as a Chief Coach and Mr Sidharth Bhaleghare as a Coach and other team member including a Physio-therapist from the WAKO India Medical Committee, Mrs Anitha Murgan. The fighters from across India were selected by their respective state associations to play in this prestigious championship in different age groups.





The 7th Turkish Open World Cup held in Istanbul from 12th to 15th May 2022 was a great success for WAKO India. It was another great tournament under the aegis of WAKO in which 44 countries took part and performed with over 3200 participants in both males and females categories.



Though her knees still hurt, she says she is glad she got to experience and understand what the competition at the international level is like. "I tend to improve my flexibility and technique, and need more experience," she says. As for the aches and pains, she says, "We go through a lot of conditioning, so that doesn't matter."

Stowfish started skating a year and a half ago at the Spryvee Kickboxing Academy in Anna Nagar. It was something she took up in October.



“I was to the World Cup, Nishida stood up her practice. Her coach made her run for 30 minutes every morning and that helped increase stamina. I was able to stand on light for 40 minutes,” she says.

She sparred with girls and boys at the academy. While sparring with one of the boys she got a bruise under her eye just before leaving for Turkey.

“We also had a national training camp with 100 participants and an international coaches from Italy, Norway and Korea. We trained twice a day for two to three weeks.”

Charged by these wins, Nishida says she is willing to not to all the practice that is required to reach the standards of the world champions. The thing with karate is you need to be prepared and have many techniques. “You can’t just rely on support to know anything in advance. Only once you are on the team, you’ll know what’s going to happen as a fighter,” And that is a difficult

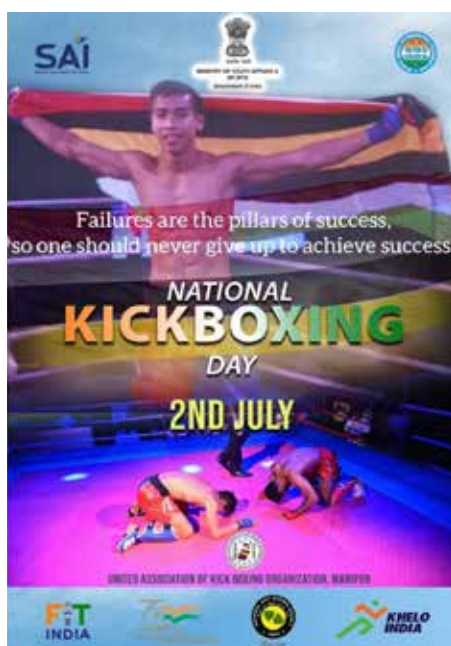

2nd WAKO India Open International Kickboxing Tournament

2nd to 6th November 2022, New Delhi

The “2nd Indian Open International Kickboxing Tournament” was organized by WAKO India Kickboxing Federation and took place from November 2–6, 2022, at the Talkatora Indoor Stadium in New Delhi.

All of the team members arrived at the venue on the first day and completed the registration process, which was followed by the medical test and weighing-in. This procedure must be followed in order for the game to be transparent and fair. It's always enjoyable to watch the fired-up youths getting ready to win the competition and represent their team with pride.

The location was fitted with 1 Ring, 3 Tatami spaces. There were total 811 entries, 551 Players, 115 Referees, 46 Coaches and 16 officials from both India and abroad who participated in the event in total.

On November 3, the “5th International Kickboxing Referee Seminar” took place. All of the Tournament Referees who attended the seminar, deemed as “Technical Training Seminar,” learned the Kickboxing rules, techniques, and procedures for awarding points during ring fights. Mr. Yury Lakhtikov (Estonia), Chairman of the Referees Committee, Ring Sports, WAKO (IF), was the seminar's featured speaker and presented to all the referees on the kickboxing rules and techniques. He spoke about topics such as Minimum Suspension Periods after KO, Prohibited Techniques in Ring Sports disciplines, Minus Point Criteria, Warnings and Minus Points, Disqualification Process, Legal Techniques in Low-kick and Target Area, and Decision Making Process, which are all related to refereeing kickboxing matches. Mr. Sanjay Kumar, Chairman of Referee Committee, Ring Sports, WAKO (India), was present.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, Mr. Brian Beck, Chairman of the Referee Committee for Tatami Sports WAKO (IF), was unable to obtain a visa in time, so Ms. Seema Saini, a member of the WAKO Referee Committee, took over to lead the seminar. Mr. Kartik Daku, Chairman of Referee Committee, Tatami Sports, WAKO (India), was present.







The Chief Guest, Shri Jitender Yadav, IAS, stated during the Opening Ceremony that it was an honor for him to be invited to such a significant event. I would like to express my gratitude to Mr. Santosh K. Agarwal, President of WAKO India, for all of his efforts in raising the profile of kickboxing. The Ministry fully supports the sport of kickboxing, and we will soon include it in the Khelo India programme. We plead all participants to play with passion and good sportsmanship; only then will the #AbIndiaKhelegaKickboxing spirit materialize. To promote kickboxing sport broadly, we are reaching out in an official manner and in unconventional ways. I want to thank everyone once more for making the event a success.

Mr. Romeo Desa, Technical Director for WAKO, stated, "I am delighted to be here for this event." I would like to express my gratitude for the hospitality and my congratulations to Mr. Santosh, President of WAKO India, for successfully organizing such a significant event. It's a crucial occasion for WAKO India and WAKO (IF). We are now very close to taking part in the Olympics. Karate has been practiced in India for many years, and now kickboxing has been added to the Indian bloodline. India has a large and talented pool of kickboxers competing at all levels and putting on outstanding performances. I'll say that kickboxing is a very safe sport, but it must be practiced consistently and properly to understand its technical aspects. Create training camps like the ones that were held in September of last year, which had a significant impact. I would recommend that players develop their technical skills and fundamental strength. I have observed players with the best technical ability, which is really pleasing to see. I'll say it again: Develop good technical skills and fundamental strength in order to survive round 3.

“#AbIndiaKhelegKickboxing” was the loud rallying cry used to start the third day. The Tatami Sports competitors engaged in thrilling and passionate battles during the qualification round. The tournament’s qualification rounds were divided into four zones: Ring 1, Tatami 1, Tatami 2, and Tatami 3. The qualifications featured 200 fights in total, including 61 fights on Tatami 1, 80 fights on Tatami 2, 40 fights on Tatami 3, and 19 ring fights. The tournament was participated by both men and women with great enthusiasm. The women’s section saw a total of 55 fights, while the men’s section saw 145 fights.



All the athletes learned about doping in sports at a NADA, National Anti-Doping Agency, Delhi seminar at the event by Col. Dr. Abhay Garg. Doping implies that a player only becomes well-known and everyone’s favourite when he has a successful career. This is the shortcut method that some athletes prefer to use to quickly advance in their careers. He motivated the players to advance on the basis of their diligence and hard work by talking to them and asking questions about doping to every player seated in the stadium. Ahead of the competition, several matches in various categories were held, and the winners were declared.



Ms. Ritika Singh, a renowned Indian actress and former kickboxer, expressed her gratitude, joy, and happiness at the competition. Ritika Singh is also the WAKO India Kickboxing Federation’s brand ambassador. She urged all of her young kickboxers to continue their training and hard work. She remarked, “I feel like I’m back home,” as soon as she arrived. She concluded by saying, “Never Give Up Your Training,” as she described her life’s journey.

She has always given her training a lot of attention, from Karate to Kickboxing to acting in movies and even now. She credited her parents for her upbringing and her success, saying they had been there for her at every turn. From the beginning of her primary education, her mother encouraged her to participate in extracurricular activities. Ritika’s father, Mohan Singh, who is also her coach and mentor, has always stood by her and pushed her to put in her best effort. She thanked WAKO India for holding the competition and sent her best wishes to all the competitors for a successful future.





On November 5th, at the “Pro Fights” of the “2nd Indian Open International Kickboxing Tournament” at the “Talkatora Stadium” in Delhi, kickboxers from India, South Korea, Jordan, and Uzbekistan took home a special prize of 1400 Euros. Pro fights had 4 rounds and included two matches between men and women. Mr. Pasupulolla Prabhu Kumar from Telangana and Saleh Muhye from Jordan squared off in the -63 weight division, and Prabhu quickly and skillfully defeated Saleh.

The second fight featured Ms. Tanisha from Haryana and Ms. Shivani Satish Rajhance from Maharashtra in the -63 weight division. Tanisha defeated Shivani in a combat that was both aggressive and exciting. The third matchup pitted Yumnam Thoisan Singh of India against Ishan Das of India in the -56 weight class. Yumnam prevailed over Ishan after a challenging and protracted contest. The fourth fight featured Ali Hassan from Jordan and Sumit Grewal from India in the -81 weight division. Ali defeated Sumit in a combat that was both aggressive and exciting. The fifth matchup was between Ms. Im Yugyeong from Korea and Ms. Shruti from India in the -48 weight division. 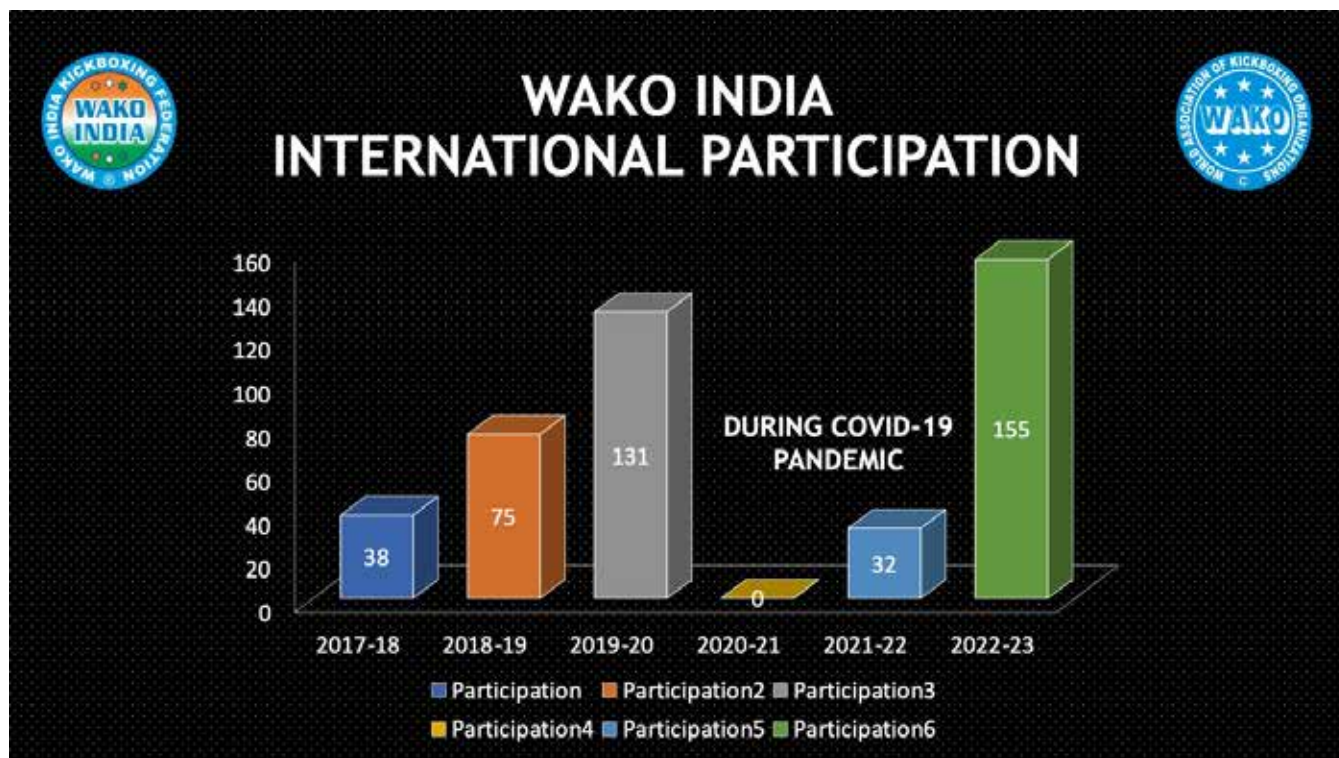

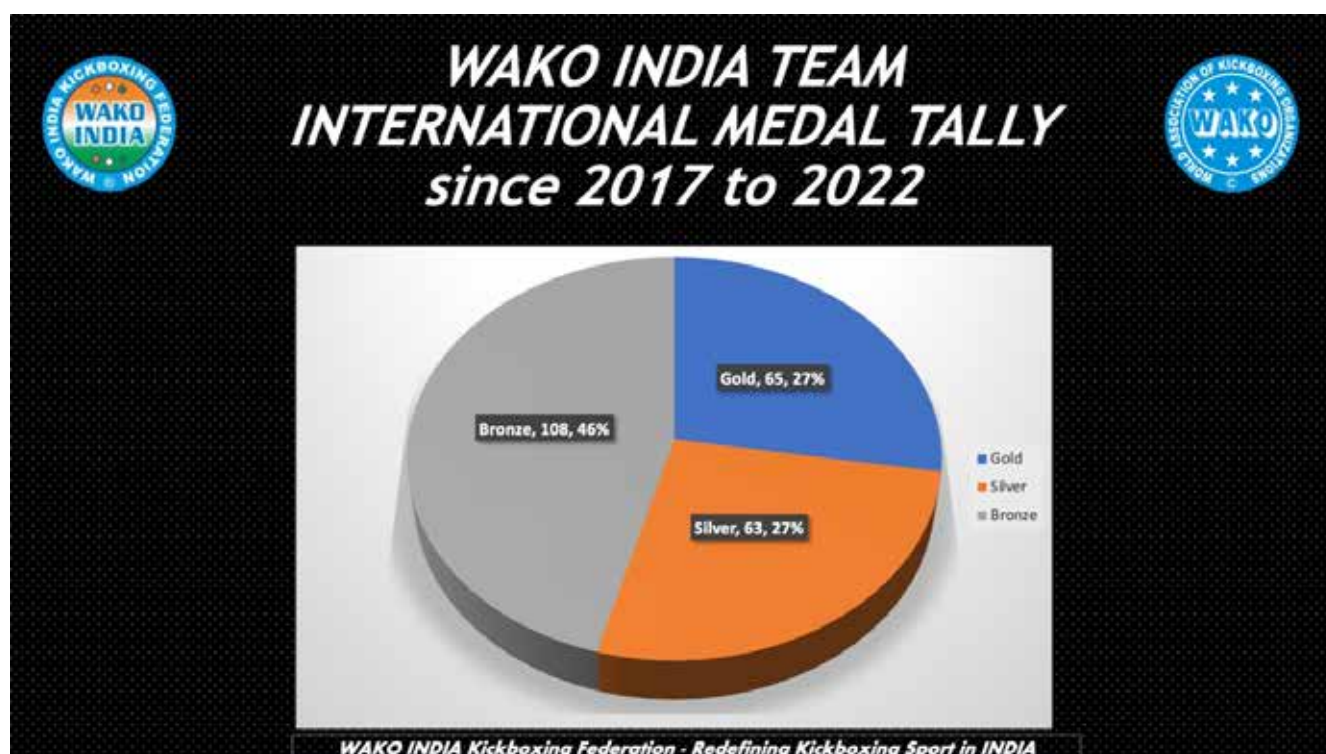
