HISTORIC OVERVIEW

WAKO's History is tightly connected with the history of Kickboxing in the western world. Already in 1970, WAKO's legend, Mr. Joe Lewis had his first "Kickboxing fight" against Mr. Greg Baines in the USA. This was the first fight where boxing gloves were used and the name Kickboxing was mentioned in the announcement.

But it was not until 1974 that the first official "World Championship in Full Contact" took place in Los Angeles. Mr. Joe Lewis and Mr. Mike Anderson were the main organizers at that time. WAKO legends Mr. Bill Wallace, Mr. Jeff Smith and Mr. Joe Lewis were the first Full Contact World Champions.

Creating a new, lasting and strong World Organization was not easy during those turbulent times in the martial art world. It was primarily Mr. George Brueckner and Mr. Mike Anderson who had the vision and the initiative to create a new "World All-Style Karate Organization" – in short "WAKO".

WAKO started its activity in Europe in 1976 and was founded in Berlin, Germany on February 26th, 1977.


The founder was Mr. Georg Bruckner from Berlin, who promoted the first ever World Championships in semi and full contact karate (as initially the discipline was called in those days) back in 1978 with 110 competitors representing 18 countries. WAKO immediately created the rules and regulations for the new fighting sports including punches (hand techniques) and kicks (leg techniques) for amateur fights with maximum use of safety equipment, the new term KICKBOXING was officially adopted to define the sport and

WAKO started to act, since the very beginning, as the authentic Kickboxing Federation in the world. From 1984 till 2013, WAKO was led by Mr. Ennio Falsoni (Italy). He organized and consolidated WAKO as respectable International Sports Organization. World Championships were held every two years in different parts of the World. Now, after decades of passionate work, Mr. Ennio Falsoni is Honorary President of WAKO.

After a period of acting presidency (2013-2015), on November 2015 in Dublin, Ireland, Prof. Borislav Pelević (Serbia) was finally elected as WAKO President, till 25th October 2018, when Prof. Pelevic suddenly passed away.

The WAKO Board of Directors then unanimously appointed Mrs. Francesca Falsoni, who is also Chairwoman of the WAKO Legal Committee, as


WAKO Interim President, in Maribor, Slovenia, on 19th November 2018.

Mrs. Falsoni made sure to lead WAKO to the next Extraordinary General Assembly for the elections of a new President, by Statutes within 6 months since the vacant position.

The WAKO Extraordinary General Assembly was finally held in Milan, Italy, on 2nd February 2019, and Mr. Roy Baker, from Ireland, was elected by majority as WAKO President.

WAKO Kickboxing today:

Kickboxing is a modern contact fighting sport created on the basis of many traditional combat sports and martial arts. Kickboxing is a unique

Western response to many Eastern martial arts. It can be practiced on competitive or recreational level depending on the aspirations of the kickboxer, but for sure it is a sport designed to improve your overall health, strength and endurance.

Today WAKO counts on 147 affiliated nations in the 5 continents, of which over 90 are officially recognized by either National Olympic Committee or relevant National Government Sports Authority.

WAKO kickboxing has 7 competitive disciplines, three Ring and four Tatami disciplines.

Ring disciplines: Full contact, Low kick, K-1 Rules.

Fighting area is the ring. Each bout consists of three two minute rounds with a minute break between each round. The intention of kickboxer is to defeat his opponent with legal techniques which must be delivered with full power.

Tatami disciplines: Point Fighting, Light Contact, Kick Light and Musical Forms (with and without weapons).

Fighting area is the tatami. The intention of kickboxer is to defeat his opponent with legal techniques which must be delivered with controlled power. Each round is two minutes with a minute break between the rounds but number of rounds is different and it depends of the discipline.

Today WAKO counts on 147 affiliated nations in the 5 continents, which are officially recognized by either National Olympic Committee or relevant National Government Sports Authority.

Nowadays there are more than 4.000.000 practitioners in more than 40.000 clubs all over the globe. WAKO is promoting Bi Annually Continental and World Championships (in all seven disciplines) and organizes World and Continental Cups and Open tournaments.



A BRIEF ON “KICKBOXING”

Kickboxing is further classified into two categories, namely 'Ring Sport' and 'Tatami Sport'. These two categories have three and four disciplines and they are mentioned below :-

RING SPORT :

- . FULL CONTACT
- . LOW KICK
- . K-1



TATAMI SPORT :

- . POINT FIGHTING
- . LIGHT CONTACT
- . KICK LIGHT
- . MUSICAL FORMS

FULL CONTACT

Full contact is a discipline of kickboxing where the intention of a fighter is to beat his opponent with full power and strength. Punches and kicks must be delivered to legal targets with focus, speed and determination, creating solid contact. Punches and kicks are allowed to the front, side and top of the head, the front and side of the body (above waist) and sweeping is also allowed. The fight is held in a ring. The Referee is responsible for fighter safety and keeping to the rules, judges count legal techniques and note the points on scoring card or with the help of the electronic system. Each fighter must have his own WAKO SPORT PASS with MEDICAL TEST in it, valid for 1 year, to be shown at weigh-in procedures. In Continental or World Championships NO FOREIGN COMPETITORS can be included in NATIONAL TEAMS. At weigh-in, official national passports must be shown to officials in charge.

LOW KICK

Low Kick can be defined as full contact kickboxing in which there is also the possibility of attacking the opponent's legs with clean kicks. All other definitions are as those of full contact kickboxing. Each fighter must have his own WAKO SPORT PASS with MEDICAL TEST in it, valid for 1 year, to be shown at weigh-in procedures. In Continental or World Championships NO FOREIGN COMPETITORS can be included in NATIONAL TEAMS. At weigh-in, official passports must be shown to the officials in charge.



K1 Rules

WAKO K-1 is a sport, like the other styles, and applies the same ring, the same weight classes and the same general rules regarding coaches or fighter's behavior that are used in Full Contact and Low Kick.

- . Elbow techniques are forbidden.
- . It is allowed to hold opponent's neck or shoulders with two hands in order to perform only one knee attack. Knee attack must be performed immediately.
- . It is forbidden to enter the ring wearing Muay Thai shorts or any other apparel of that discipline.
- . It is not allowed to grab the leg and punch or kick at the same time. .
- . Punching techniques reaching legal targets have the same value for judges as knee, leg or any other technique in the repertoire.

Each fighter must have their own WAKO SPORT PASS with MEDICAL TEST in it, valid for 1 year, to be shown at weigh-in procedures. In Continental or World Championships NO FOREIGN COMPETITORS can be included in NATIONAL TEAMS. At weigh-in, official passports must be shown to the officials in charge.



POINT FIGHT

Point Fighting is a fighting discipline where two fighters fight with the primary goal of scoring Defined points/ using controlled legal Techniques with speed agility and focus. The main characteristic of point fighting is delivery, technique and speed. The competition in point fighting should be executed in its true sense with well-controlled contact. It is a technical discipline with equal emphasis put on hand and foot techniques, from an athletic viewpoint. Techniques (punches and kicks) are strictly controlled. At each valid point (point that is given, with legal part of hand or foot to legal targets and with legal technique), the central referee halts the fight and at the same time as the two judges, shows with his/her fingers the number of points in the direction of the fighter who is being awarded the point or points.



LIGHT CONTACT

Competition in Light Contact kickboxing should be executed as its name implies, with well-controlled techniques. In light contact, competitors fight continuously until central referee command STOP or BREAK. They use techniques from full contact and Semi Contact, but these techniques must be well controlled when they land on legal targets. Equal emphasis must be placed on both punching and kicking techniques. Light contact has been created as an intermediate stage between semi and full contact kickboxing. It is carried out with running time. The central referee does not judge the fighters, but only makes sure they respect the rules. Three judges make the complete scoring decisions on normal WAKO scoring sheets or by electronic scoring board.

KICK LIGHT

Competition in Kick-Light kickboxing should be executed as its name implies, with well-controlled techniques. In Kick-Light, competitors fight continuously until central referee command STOP or BREAK. They use techniques from full contact, but these techniques must be well controlled when they land on legal targets. Equal emphasis must be placed on both punching and kicking techniques. Kick-Light has been created as an intermediate stage between semi and full contact kickboxing. It is carried out with running time. The central referee doesn't judge the fighters, but only makes sure they respect the rules. Three judges make the complete scoring decisions in an electronically scoring system or by clickers.



MUSICAL FORMS

A Musical Form is a sort of imaginary fight against one or more opponents in which the performer uses techniques coming from Oriental Martial Arts to specifically chosen music. The choice of music is personal.

CREATIVE FORM - A Creative form is a sort of imaginary fight against one or more opponents in which the performer uses techniques coming from Oriental Martial Arts.

RHYTHM: All Forms divisions must be performed to music. Martial Arts techniques must go according to the rhythm; Art.

PRESENTATIONS / LENGTH / TIME: There are no time limits for any musical forms categories, the competitor starts his / her form after their presentation from their first movement after their presentation, this can be a Trick, Gymnastic or Martial arts technique. Please Note: If a Competitor performs any Gymnastic techniques or Weapon Releases in their Presentation these will be counted as part of their form.

This recognition has empowered WAKO India to pursue its mission of revolutionizing kickboxing in India, epitomized by the declaration of July 2nd as “National Kickboxing Day.”

As a member of WAKO (IF), recognized by the International Olympic Committee (IOC), WAKO India has gained global prominence, with 147 countries affiliated. Through dedicated efforts, it has risen to 47th position in the world rankings and 5th in Asia among kickboxing nations.

With 34 affiliates spanning states and union territories, all registered with respective State Sports Authorities, some also recognized by State Olympic Associations, WAKO India operates in close collaboration with these entities to advance kickboxing nationwide. These affiliates, including representatives at district levels, ensure grassroots development of the sport, extending its reach even to remote areas.

WAKO India, in partnership with its affiliates, sports authorities, and state Olympic associations, organizes numerous kickboxing competitions nationwide, garnering enthusiastic participation and support, thus advancing the sport’s popularity and growth.

The successful conclusion of the 3rd India Open International Kickboxing Tournament, featuring a diverse range of events across multiple categories, held from February 7-11, 2024, marks a significant milestone. Hosted at the esteemed KD Jadhav Indoor Stadium, IG Sports Complex, New Delhi, India, the tournament symbolizes a fusion of athleticism, expertise, and global unity.

In tandem with the tournament, WAKO India takes immense pride in orchestrating the 6th WAKO International Kickboxing Referee Seminar. Attendees are invited to engage in a Gala Event, offering lucrative cash prizes and captivating awards, with participation open to both national and international contenders from over 20 countries.

Welcoming esteemed dignitaries for the first time, including Mr. Roy Baker, President of the World Association of Kickboxing Organizations



(WAKO) Ireland, alongside distinguished guests, among others countries, alongside national delegates, adds to the grandeur of the occasion.

Under the dynamic leadership of Mr. Santosh Kumar Agrawal, President of WAKO India Kickboxing Federation, this event embodies a testament to the commitment and passion driving the sport’s growth and excellence.

In India, kickboxing has gained recognition at both the school and university levels, being incorporated into the sports calendars of the School Games Federation of India (SGFI) and the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) respectively.

The Sports Authority of India (SAI) has incorporated our sport into the Khelo India program, specifically the “Khelo India Women’s Kickboxing League 2023-24.” We have already successfully concluded events in 22 cities, engaging over 10,000 female athletes.

In 2022, our athletes showcased remarkable prowess by clinching 10 medals at the Cadet & Juniors World Championship held in Italy and securing 25 medals at the Asian Kickboxing Championship held in Thailand.


